The stretch along 17th Avenue shown in the accompanying map is barren of trees and the lack of shade is requiring excessive water to keep the turf from dying. This is a very large expanse of open turf. Adjoining neighborhoods have planted shade trees in along 17th Ave for this very reason. We are one long stretch of the road with inadequate tree development.
